In the 2009 examination diet in Edinburgh, 9,496 pupils gained a total of 45,136 results.

Awards were attained from a range of 69 different subjects – from Accounting to Woodworking Skills.

Awards

Overall, numbers of awards for Access 3, Higher, Intermediate 2 and Advanced Higher courses increased on the previous year. Overall numbers of Standard Grade and Intermediate 1 awards decreased on the previous year.

Standard Grades

Numbers of Standard Grade awards in S3 have continued to increase. Good progress has been made in the following subjects, Biology, Geography, Mathematics, Music and Physics.

Overall, the numbers of no awards at Standard Grade have continued to decrease

Highers in S5

The numbers of Higher passes in S5 have increased on the previous year. Overall, the number of pupils gaining 5 or more Higher passes A-C in S5 is broadly in line with previous years.

Subjects where improvement has been sustained include: Biology, Business Management, Computing, English and Spanish.

Advanced Higher

Overall, the numbers of passes at Advanced Higher have improved on the previous year. Passes in a number of subjects have improved, including, Applied Mathematics, Computing, English, Geography, Graphic Communication, History, Modern Studies, Music and Physics.
