Executive summary

An invitation has been received from the Mayor of Fuzhou, China, for the Lord Provost to travel to the city with the Scotland Fujian Chamber of Commerce.

Fuzhou is a trade port, located on China's southeast coast on the maritime 'Silk Road'.

Due to the timing of the invitation and the need to confirm arrangements for the Lord Provost, a decision to accept the invitation was required to be made under Paragraph 4.1 of the Committee Terms of Reference and Delegated Functions.



Report

Invitation to Fuzhou

1. Recommendations

- 1.1 The Committee is asked to:
 - 1.1.1 Note the acceptance of the invitation extended to the Lord Provost from the Mayor of Fuzhou to visit Fuzhou with the Scotland Fujian Chamber of Commerce. Due to the timing of the invitation and the need to confirm arrangements for the Lord Provost, a decision to be represented was required to be made under Paragraph 4.1 of the Committee Terms of Reference and Delegated Function; and
 - 1.1.2 Note that a post-visit report will be provided after the event.

2. Background

Fuzhou

- 2.1 The city of Fuzhou is located in the southeast coast of China, and the city has a population of over 7.5 million. It is identified as a gateway along the maritime 'Silk Road', and its industries are concerned with the modernisation of the Chinese navy, technology, and mechanical equipment.
- 2.2 Fuzhou is in the process of developing a New Area: a Free Trade Pilot Zone to align with the 21st Century Maritime 'Silk Road'.

3. Main Report

Visit Programme

- 3.1 The invitation to the Lord Provost to visit Fuzhou is to provide a wider understanding of the city. Further detail regarding the programme is pending.
- 3.2 Due to the timing of the invitation and the need to confirm arrangements for the Lord Provost, a decision to be represented was required to be made under Paragraph 4.1 of the Committee Terms of Reference and Delegated Function.
- 3.3 The invitation has been accepted on behalf for the Lord Provost to attend.

4. Measures of success

- 4.1 Attendance in Fuzhou by the Lord Provost will raise Edinburgh's profile in southeast China.
- 4.2 Feedback reports are provided on all international travel commitments made by elected members.

5. Financial impact

5.1 The cost of flights, accommodation and local expenses for the Lord Provost and the City Officer will be met by the City of Fuzhou.
