### 1. Minutes of meeting of 29<sup>th</sup> August 2016 for approval

The minutes of the Board's meeting of 29<sup>th</sup> August 2016, together with the decision list from that meeting, were presented for approval.

**Decision:** Minutes approved.

### 2. Applications for variation of existing premises licences, new premises and provisional premises licences, personal licences, etc – as detailed in separate list

The Board considered nine applications for variation of existing premises licences, six applications for new provisional premises licences and seven applications for personal licences, the decisions for which are as detailed in the list appended to these minutes.

**Declarations of interest:** Councillor Booth declared a non-financial interest in the following application and took no part in the decision-making process.

Councillor Cook, seconded by Councillor Balfour, moved refusal of the application, having regard to the licensing objective of preventing crime and disorder. Councillor Milligan, seconded by Councillor Walker, moved grant of the application.

**Decision:** Details of the decisions for each application are as set out in the list attached to these minutes.

### **3. Premises Licence Review Proposal – 1 Dean Bank Lane, Edinburgh**

The Depute Clerk advised the Board that the premises licence for 1 Dean Bank Lane was held in the name of a company which it had been established had been dissolved. The Board noted that the premises had not come to the attention of police or LSOs, and that there had been, and continued to be, a premises manager employed at the premises throughout.

The Board agreed that it was necessary to make a review proposal, but that no action would be taken on the premises licence until the meeting of 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016.

**Decision:** Board agreed that it was necessary to make a review proposal, and that the matter would be continued for consideration at the meeting on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016.
