1. Minutes of Meeting of:-

(a) 29th October 2018

The Minutes and decision list for the meeting of 29th October 2018 were agreed as providing an accurate record of that meeting.

(b) 13th November 2018

The Minutes of the meeting of 13th November 2018 were agreed as providing an accurate record of that meeting.

2. Applications for variation of existing premises licences, new premises and provisional premises licences, personal licences, etc - as detailed in separate list

The Board considered seven applications for variation of premises licences, three application for transfer and variation and nine applications for provisional premises licences, the decisions for which are as detailed in the list appended to these minutes.

Section 45 – Extension of Provisional Period – 20-30 Cockburn Street, Edinburgh

The Depute Clerk advised of an application for extension of provisional period, for a licence which was due to expire at the end of January 2019. Alistair Macdonald was present on behalf of the licence holder and explained the reasons for the extension. After due consideration, the Board agreed to a one year extension.

4. Section 83 Notification - Neil Young

The Board noted Mr Young was not in attendance. The Depute Clerk explained that several attempts had been made to contact him, without success. The Board agreed to proceed with the hearing in his absence.

After hearing from Sergeant Young regarding the notification details, the Board agreed that it was necessary for the purposes of the licensing objectives to revoke Mr Young's personal licence.

Statement of Licensing Policy updates:-

(a) Assessment of Overprovision

The Depute Clerk referred to a detailed report which was presented to the Board, and narrated its terms in full. The Board had previously given full and detailed consideration to overprovision localities at its meeting on 13th November 2018. The Depute Clerk reminded the Board of the processes gone through in arriving at a decision on overprovision localities, and the evidence which had been considered by the Board. At the conclusion of the meeting of 13th November the Board had given provisional agreement to four specific localities, defined by Intermediate Data Zone boundaries, as being designated as overprovision localities in respect of all licence types:

- Old Town, Princes Street and Leith Street
- Tollcross
- Southside, Canongate and Dumbiedykes
- Deans Village

The report before the Board recommended consideration of a new draft Assessment of Overprovision, on the basis that if approved it would then be incorporated into the new policy statement.

Board members discussed the terms of the report and the draft assessment, in considerable detail. Councillor Burgess advised he had an amendment to make to the recommendation. Following discussion about the designation of localities, he confirmed he was asking that the Board consider including the following additional ID zones as being overprovision localities:

- The Shore and Constitution Street
- Great Junction Street



- South Leith
- Leith (Albert Street)
- Pilrig

The Board was provided with further advice from the Depute Clerk about the designation of overprovision localities. Councillor Burgess, seconded by Councillor Cameron, moved that the nine areas detailed above should be designated as overprovision localities. Councillor Mowat, seconded by Councillor Fullerton, moved that the original four areas should be declared as overprovision localities. Following a division, the majority decision was that the four localities of:

- Old Town, Princes Street and Leith Street
- Tollcross
- Southside, Canongate and Dumbiedykes
- Deans Village

should be declared as overprovision localities, and that the draft Chapter 8 on overprovision should be incorporated into the policy.

(b) General Licensing Policy

The Depute Clerk referred to the terms of the report on the Board's draft Statement of Licensing Policy, setting out the details of amendments made to the policy document following the Board's consultation.

She advised the draft policy document, incorporating the overprovision assessment as agreed above, was now before the Board for approval and publication.

Councillor Burgess asked the Board to consider an amendment to the part of the policy covering operating hours (Chapter 11), to the effect that the Board would adhere to the terms of Scottish Government guidance with a maximum of 14 hours for on sales rather than the 16 currently referred to in the policy. Further discussion followed among Board members. Councillor Burgess moved that the policy be amended to confirm a 14 hour maximum, with a degree of flexibility during Festival periods, and was seconded by Councillor Day. Councillor Gloyer moved approval of the draft policy as currently worded, and was seconded by Councillor Fullerton. Following a division, the majority decision was to approve the draft policy as currently worded, incorporating the new assessment of overprovision as agreed.

6. Annual Functions Report – 2017/18

The Depute Clerk advised the Board of the requirement to agree and publish an annual functions report, setting out details of the Board's decision making having regard to the licensing objectives and the terms of its policy statement in the preceding financial year.



The Board noted the terms of a report which had been prepared for consideration, and agreed to the adoption of its terms, subject to an amendment by Councillor Mowat to include reference to the work carried out by the Council's Governance, Risk and Best Value Committee on the appointment arrangements for the Licensing Forum. The Board instructed that the report should be published.

7. Annual Finance Report – 2017/18

The Depute Clerk advised the Board of the requirement to publish a financial report for the previous financial year, setting out details of the Board's income and expenditure over that period.

Andrew Mitchell was in attendance to report on the details of the income and expenditure, and to respond to questions from members of the Board. Following consideration of the report and supporting information provided by Mr Mitchell, it was agreed the report should be published.

8. Gambling Act 2005 – Statement of Licensing Policy – consultation

The Depute Clerk advised the Board of the requirement for review of the Board's existing Statement of Gambling Licensing Policy, upon which the Board would be required to consult. Following consultation, a new policy would require to be published.

The Depute Clerk advised the timescale for publication of the new policy was relatively short, and a short consultation was suggested. A draft policy document was provided for the Board's consideration, with a number of amendments having been highlighted. He suggested the Board could consider carrying out separate work on the identification of Local Area Profiles, for inclusion in the policy at a later date.

The Board agreed to consult upon the draft policy. The Board also agreed that further work would be carried out on Local Area Profiles, once the consultation had concluded.

1. Gambling Act 2005 - Statement of Licensing Policy - update

The Depute Clerk presented a report to the Board, advising of the outcome of the Board's consultation on the terms of its new Gambling Statement of Licensing Policy. He highlighted the responses received to the consultation and asked the Board to consider whether any further amendments were required in view of the responses received. He explained the publication requirements in order for the new policy to take effect, and confirmed that a further report would be presented to a future Board meeting on the subject of Local Area Profiles.

Board members discussed the terms of the responses received, and the terms of the new policy. The Board was concerned to improve community involvement in the gambling licensing process, and agreed it would be beneficial for applicants seeking new premises licences to engage with local community councils and that the policy should be amended to that extent.

The Board noted that a report on Local Area Profiles would be presented to a future meeting. The Board agreed to approve the terms of the policy and agreed to its publication.

1. Purpose

2. Main Report

- 2.1. The 2005 Act allows the Board to make, and publish, rules for its meetings. Paragraph 12, schedule 1 deals specifically with proceedings at Board meetings.
- 2.2. The Edinburgh Licensing Board has previously agreed rules for its meetings, setting the frequency of meetings (monthly) and generally on the last Monday in each month other than during holiday months, particularly July and December.
- 2.3. To ensure a co-ordination between meeting dates scheduled for the Licensing Board and the City of Edinburgh Council and its committees, dates of meetings are agreed annually, several months in advance. A suggested draft schedule of meetings dates for the 2019/20 period is attached. The Board meeting dates have been extracted from that and are set out in the rules below.
- 2.4. The schedule does not include specific provision for additional Board meetings, such as the requirement to hold a joint meeting with the Licensing Forum. Board members may also wish to consider whether a regular date for site visits might be achievable, in view of their regularity.
- 2.5. Details of the dates agreed by the Board will be communicated to the Council to ensure the Council calendar is up to date. The Council calendar is due to be finalised in February 2019. Details of meeting dates will also be published online, to ensure that all interested parties are aware of arrangements for Board meetings.

PREMISES LICENCE REVIEW PROPOSAL - NOTIFICATION OF CONVICTION FOR RELEVANT OFFENCE - TESCO STORES LIMITED

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To advise the Board of a notification of conviction details for a premises licence holder;
- 1.2 To invite the Board to consider whether it is necessary to make a premises licence review proposal.

2. Main Report

- 2.1. Premises licence holders have a duty to inform the Licensing Board if they are convicted for a relevant offence. The 2005 Act provides a definition of what is considered to be a "relevant offence". The Chief Constable is required to provide the Board with a notice confirming the conviction details, or otherwise, and may make a recommendation with regard to the premises licence holder's licence(s) if it is considered necessary for any of the licensing objectives.
- 2.2. Where the Board receives a notice from the Chief Constable confirming the conviction details but containing no recommendation, the Board has a discretion to decide whether it is considered necessary to make a review proposal, or to note the details and take no action.
- 2.3. The review proposal relates to a number of premises licences granted by the Board. The holder of those premises licences is Tesco Stores Limited. Their agents have intimated details of convictions for relevant offences. Details of their premises are listed in the appendix to the agent's letter, a copy of which was sent to the Chief Constable and a copy of his notice in response will be circulated to members.
- 2.4 This matter is reported to the Board to consider whether it is necessary to make a review proposal and hold a hearing at a later date, or note the details of the conviction but take no further action.

3. Recommendation

- 3.1 The Board is asked:-
 - (a) to note the details of the notification made by the licence holder, and the representation from Police Scotland; and
 - (b) to decide whether it is necessary for the purposes of any of the licensing objectives to hold a hearing at a later date, or take no further action.

PERSONAL LICENCE REVIEW - PANKAJ RAWAT

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To advise the Board of a notification of conviction details, for a personal licence holder;
- 1.2 To invite the Board to consider whether to proceed with a review hearing.

2. Main Report

- 2.1. Mr Pankaj Rawat holds a Personal Licence issued by the Edinburgh Licensing Board. Where a personal licence holder acquires a conviction for a relevant offence they are required to provide the Licensing Board with notification to that effect. Notice is then sent to the Chief Constable in order for him to provide a notice either confirming the conviction details or otherwise. It is open to the Chief Constable to make a recommendation to the Board if it is considered necessary for the purposes of the licensing objectives.
- 2.2. In this instance Mr Rawat has not provided the notification: it has come directly from Police Scotland. The police have not made any recommendation to the Board in terms of the licensing objectives.
- 2.3. The Board has a discretion to decide whether or not to proceed with a hearing, or to take no further action. If the Board is satisfied that it is necessary to do so for the purposes of any of the licensing objectives, it may make an order:-
 - (a) revoking;
 - (b) suspending for such period, not exceeding 6 months, as the Board considers appropriate, or
 - (c) endorsing

the licence held by the personal licence holder. If in the course of the hearing the Board considers the licence holder is no longer a fit and proper person to hold the licence, the Board may revoke the licence.

The Board is required to decide whether to hold a hearing on Mr Rawat's personal licence and then decide what action, if any, is considered necessary for the purpose of the licensing objectives. Mr Rawat has been invited to attend the Board meeting.

3. Recommendation

- 3.1 The Board is required, having regard to the notification and the Chief Constable's report:-
 - (a) to decide whether or not to hold a hearing on the personal licence;
 - (b) if proceeding with a hearing, to decide what action to take with regard to the personal licence.

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The Board having agreed the terms of its new Statement of Licensing Policy, to confirm arrangements for future consideration of Occasional Licence applications;
- 1.2 To advise the Board of details of premises currently operating on the basis of repeated use of Occasional Licences;

2. Main Report

- 2.1 Details of applications for Occasional Licences are published online, updated on a weekly basis, on the Council's website at http://www.edinburgh.gov.uk/downloads/download/825/alcohol_licence_registers
 Applications are considered by Board members on a rota basis, in terms of the Board's Scheme of Delegation. During preparation of the Board's new Statement of Licensing Policy it was agreed that in certain circumstances applications for occasional licences should be referred to the full Board for consideration.
- 2.2 Chapter 5 of the statement sets out the terms of the Board's policy on occasional Licence applications. Paragraph 5.4 includes the following:-
 - "...the Board has agreed that where applications for Occasional Licences are received for a continuous trading period of more than two months or alternatively more than four consecutive applications, then such further applications will generally be referred to the Board for determination."
- 2.3 The Council's Licensing Service has provided details of premises which currently operate on the basis of extended use of Occasional Licences. Details are provided at appendix one. In some instances, premises have a provisional Premises Licence in place and Occasional Licences are being used by licence holders as an interim measure, pending an application being made for Confirmation. In others, premises are being licensed solely on the basis of Occasional Licences.
- 2.4 In addition to the circumstances set out above, there may be instances when police, LSOs or Building Standards Officers may wish to make representations about individual applications for Occasional Licences being referred to full Board for consideration. In these instances where timescales permit, applications will be reported to the Board.
- 2.5 At this stage, the list of premises as set out in appendix one is provided to the Board for noting, as an indication of the number of premises which have operated and continue to do so, over an extended period of time. The Board is asked to consider the basis upon which future applications are referred for consideration.
