## Championing Best Practice – National Best Bar None National Awards 2018/19 National Champion – The Black Rose Tavern, Edinburgh

I'd like to make the Board aware that following on from the Edinburgh Best Bar None Awards held on the evening of the 21<sup>st</sup> November 2018, two of Edinburgh's Category award winning venues, the Black Rose Tavern and the Gorgie Suite at Heart of Midlothian Football Club, applied for the national Best Bar None Awards scheme. The National Best Bar None Awards scheme is only open to local category winning venues, and is a chance for local winners to compete against the best award winning venues across Scotland.

The National Best Bar None scheme supports venues delivery of safe and inclusive social spaces, whilst rewarding social responsibility and duty of care. Key Partners and trade from across Scotland celebrated the licenced trade's achievements at an awards evening on Thursday 28th March at the DoubleTree Dunblane Hydro Hotel in Dunblane. The venues have considered not only their commitment and diligence in relation to their licensing commitments as key drivers for their businesses, but more importantly their customers and staff. A group of finalists took part in the annual national awards across eleven award categories with venues represented from the length and breadth of Scotland. There are twelve categories within the award scheme: Pub, Independent Pub, Bar, Independent Bar, Hotel, Night Club, SEV, Heart of the Community, Newcomer, Innovation in Social Responsibility and National Champion.

The Licensing Standards Officers support the Best Bar None scheme as a platform which encourages and promotes best practice in participating venues. The Black Rose has been taking part in the Edinburgh Best Bar None scheme since 2015, and has won

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a Gold award every year from 2015 to 2018 inclusive, with its annual score increasing year on year. This has contributed to the Black Rose being nominated for a National Award in 2017/18, and winning the Overall Award in Edinburgh for both 2017 and 2018, with 2018 representing the highest Best Bar None score ever awarded in Edinburgh.

At the 2018/19 National Best Bar None Awards the Black Rose Tavern was awarded the top overall National Champion Award, and in addition also won the following categories;

- Best Independent Pub
- Innovation in Social Responsibility
- Platinum Award (for consistent commitment to best practice within the licensed trade)

Their continued success is driven by "the two Alison's", Alison Morrison and Alison Wilson, who are extremely pro-active supporters of the Best Bar None scheme and best practice. They have been directly involved with the introduction and support of a number of significant nationally recognised schemes, such as bringing the "Ask Angela" scheme to Scotland more than two years ago. They've recently introduced a scheme which prevents drinks spiking via modified beer mats, and were actively promoting it during the National Awards evening even after winning all of the above National Awards. They attribute their success to their continued commitment and investment in developing their own knowledge and experience, including their staff, via ongoing training and development and review of best practice. As a result the Black Rose Tavern is recognised as one of Edinburgh's premier establishments, and has now been recognised nationally as the National Best Bar None Champion for 2018/19.

#### **Preliminary Matters**

#### 1. Minutes of Meeting of (a) 25th February 2019 (b) 11th March 2019

The Minutes of the meetings of 25<sup>th</sup> February and 11<sup>th</sup> March 2019 were approved.

#### 2. Festivals 2019 – Seasonal Variation of licensed hours

The Depute Clerk referred to a report, setting out the terms of the Board's policy on extended hours during the Edinburgh International Festival and Fringe Festival, 2019.

The Board agreed the extended hours policy would apply between 2<sup>nd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019, inclusive. A two hour extension to licensed hours would apply to all premises where this was provided for in their operating plans. Licences which did not contain the relevant seasonal variation in their operating plan would be able to make applications for extended hours.

## 3. (a) Request to extend provisional period (continued) – 34 Hamilton Place

The agent for the licence holder advised the Board that the request to extend the provisional period was withdrawn. The Board noted that no further action was required.

#### (b) Request to extend provisional period – 234-246 Easter Road

The Depute Clerk referred to an application for extension of provisional period, for the Lidl premises at 234-246 Easter Road. Andrew Hunter was present on behalf of Lidl and explained the reasons for the extension. The Board noted that the licence had already been extended by six months. The agent advised there were

still outstanding issues preventing a section 50 certificate being obtained from the Council's Building Standards section, which meant the provisional licence could not be confirmed. The Board heard from the Council's Building Standards officer in that regard.

The Board noted that the premises were operating in the meantime on the basis of occasional licences. The Board agreed to an extension of the provisional period to 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019 being the date of its next meeting, noting that the agent hoped to be able to provide an update to the Board on that date.

#### 7. Review of premises licence - Oceana Bar, 145 Ferry Road, Edinburgh

The Depute Clerk advised of the basis upon which the review hearing was proceeding. The Board heard from Tom Veitch who confirmed the details of the application for review, made by the Council's LSOs. Alistair Macdonald was present on behalf of the licence holder Caledonian Heritable Limited and was accompanied by the tenant of the premises.

The Board noted that efforts were being made to try and address the problems identified by the review application, including the fitting of a volume limiter to the jukebox in the premises. The Board agreed that in order to allow these efforts to continue, no action would be taken with the premises licence at this stage.

In the event that matters could not be resolved, the LSOs would report the matter back to the Board for further consideration.

## 8. Review of premises licence – Fountain News, 157 Dundee Street, Edinburgh

The Depute Clerk advised the Board of the basis on which the review hearing was proceeding. The Board heard from Alistair Macdonald on behalf of the licence holder, who advised that he had only recently been instructed by the licence holder. He asked the Board to consider continuing the review hearing to a later date.

The Board considered the continuation request in detail, and decided to schedule an additional meeting in order that the review hearing could proceed, to take place on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2019.

#### 9. Section 84A Review of personal licence - Christopher Stewart

The Depute Clerk advised of the basis upon which the review hearing was proceeding. The Board heard from Sergeant Young on the terms of the police application for review of Mr Stewart's personal licence. The Board then heard from Alistair Macdonald on Mr Stewart's behalf.

Following detailed consideration of the representations made, the Board agreed that it was necessary for the purposes of the licensing objectives to endorse Mr Stewart's licence.

1. Review of premises licence – Fountain News, 157 Dundee Street, Edinburgh

The Depute Clerk referred to a report before the Board, confirming the hearing had been continued from the meeting of 25<sup>th</sup> March to allow the licence holder additional time to consult with their agent. The Board heard from Sergeant Young who narrated the basis on which the review application had been made, and heard from Tom Veitch on the terms of the LSO report. The Board heard from Alistair Macdonald on behalf of his clients, noting that Andrew Williams was also present to assist.

Following consideration of the detailed representations made, the Board agreed that it was necessary for the purposes of the licensing objectives to revoke the premises licence.
