1. Personal Licence Renewals - Update

The Depute Clerk provided the Board with an update on numbers of personal licence holders whose licences were due to expire later in the year unless applications for renewal were submitted in time. The first significant date was 31st May 2019 for personal licences which were due to expire as at 31st August 2019. The following details were noted:-

Renewal applications received/granted as at 26th April:

- 399 x Personal Licence Renewal applications received.
- 254 x applications granted.

The maximum number of expected renewals for all Personal Licenses expiring this year is as follows:

- Licenses due to expire on 31st August 2019 (renewals received no later than 31st May): 910 (259 received)
- 30 September 2019 (30th June): 249 (58)
- 31 October 2019 (31st July): 443 (56)
- 30 November 2019 (31st August): 134 (20)
- 31 December 2019 (30th September): 20 (6)

Total 1,756 (399)

2. Best Bar None Awards - 2018/19

Tom Veitch advised the Board about the National Best Bar None awards, and the role the scheme played in rewarding the successful operation of licensed premises according to particular criteria. The Board recognised the achievements of those involved in the awards scheme and congratulated the



efforts of the Black Rose Tavern for winning the National Best Bar None award for 2018/19.

3. Minutes of Meeting of (a) 25th March 2019; (b) 2nd April 2019

The minutes of the meetings of 25th March and 2nd April 2019 were noted and approved.

4. Request to extend provisional period – 234-246 Easter Road

The Board heard from Andrew Hunter on behalf of Lidl, the licence holder. He advised that progress continued to be made towards being able to apply for confirmation of the provisional premises licence. He asked the Board to continue the provisional period for a further month to allow work to continue towards a confirmation application being submitted.

The Board agreed to extend the provisional period to 27th May 2019.

The Board considered three applications for transfer and variation of premises licence, fourteen applications for variation of premises licences, one application for premises licence and seven applications for provisional premises licences, the decisions for which are as detailed in the list appended to these minutes.

Councillor Gloyer, seconded by Councillor Mowat, moved grant of the application but with the terminal hour for alcohol sales being 2200 Sunday – Thursday and 0000 Friday - Saturday. Councillor Fullerton, seconded by Councillor Cook, moved an amendment that the application be granted with a terminal hour of 2300 Monday – Thursday, 0000 Friday - Sunday. Following a division the motion was carried, with the terminal hour for alcohol sales being 2200 Sunday – Thursday and 0000 Friday - Saturday.

Following a division Councillor Work used his casting vote and the application was granted.

Councillor Work, seconded by Councillor Laidlaw, moved that the application for premises licence could proceed to grant, on the basis that the premises were not excluded premises, in terms of section 123(5) of the 2005 Act. Councillor Gloyer, seconded by Councillor Mowat, moved an amendment that the premises were excluded premises and could not proceed for a decision on grant. Following a division the motion was carried and the application was granted.

The Depute Clerk advised of a requirement to review Abbas Afzal's personal licence, following a premises licence review hearing held at the Board's meeting on 2nd April 2019. The Board heard from John Young on behalf of Police Scotland and from Alistair Macdonald on behalf of Mr Afzal.

Following consideration of the representations made, the Board decided that it would take no action with the personal licence.

11. Letter from Local Government and Communities Committee

The Depute Clerk advised of a letter received from the Scottish Parliament's Local Government and Communities Committee, which invited responses from the Board to a number of themes set out in the letter. The Board agreed it would be preferable to provide a response to the letter if time allowed, noting the requested date for responses of 13th May 2019.

12. Scottish Government Consultation – Draft Guidance – Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005

The Depute Clerk advised the Scottish Government was carrying out a consultation on the terms of its proposed new draft guidance, for the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005. The new draft guidance took account of amendments which had been made to the 2005 Act, since its commencement in 2009.

The Board noted the date by which responses to the consultation should be made was 11th June 2019.
