# 1. Parade – Korrika Scotland Fun Run

Details were provided of a notification received from Korrika Scotland to hold a fun run on 13 April 2019. The application had been continued from the meeting of the Licensing Sub-Committee on 11 March 2019 to allow the applicant to attend.
