Executive Summary

The City of Edinburgh Council has been notified of a parades which is proposed to take place in June 2019.

The Council has limited powers in respect of parades. It can take no action and the parades would proceed as the organisers intend. Alternatively, it has the power to attach conditions or, under limited circumstances, to ban the parades. The Committee needs to decide whether to exercise any of these options.

In January 2018 the Regulatory Committee decided to continue the practice that all parades involving the High Street must be submitted for Committee consideration.



Proposed Parades and Processions: June 2019

1. **Recommendations**

1.1 It is recommended that the Committee makes an order in respect of the proposed parade, imposing conditions attached at Appendix 2.

2. Background

- 2.1 Under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, anyone organising a parade or procession in Scotland must notify the appropriate local authority and the police at least 28 days prior to the date of the event.
- 2.2 The City of Edinburgh Council has been notified of intent to hold the 'Escort to the Crown of Scotland' parade in the city on 29 June 2019. It is proposed that the parade will use the High Street:
- 2.3 The Council has limited powers available regarding the control of parades. These powers should only normally be exercised to prevent public disorder, risk to public safety, damage to property or excessive disruption to the life of the community.

3. Main report

- 3.1 Notification forms and other documents relevant to the proposed parade are attached as Appendix 1.
- 3.2 The recommended conditions (Appendix 2) are sufficient to mitigate any possible disruption to the community.
- 3.3 Representatives of the organisation will be invited to address the Committee regarding the proposed parade.

4. Measures of success

- 4.1 That the Council discharges its statutory duties in respect of these notifications.
- 4.2 That any parade is facilitated wherever possible and is managed in a way that minimises potential disruption to the life of the community.

5. **Financial impact**

5.1 None arising directly from this report.

5.2 Council resources may need to be deployed on the day, in particular with respect to any road closures.

6. Risk, policy, compliance and governance impact

6.1 Should the Committee decide to restrict or prohibit the procession, the persons proposing to hold the procession may appeal against that decision to the Sheriff Court within 14 days of written reasons being received by them.

7. Equalities impact

7.1 In coming to a decision, the Committee will have to consider the rights of the procession organisers to stage their procession, and the Council's duty to foster good relations and ensure the protection of public order and safety. These must be discharged against the relevant statutory duties.

8. **Sustainability impact**

- 8.1 There may be some short-term environmental impact arising from any agreed procession:
 - 8.1.1 The proposed route crosses public roads, though arrangements will be made to mitigate any disruption caused.

9. Consultation and engagement

9.1 Statutory consultation has taken place regarding the parades.

Executive Summary

A Public Entertainment License application has been received for Armed Forces Day 2019. Armed Forces Day is 22 June 2019. The Lord Provost has written to request that the Regulatory Sub-Committee consider waiving the fee for this Public Entertainment License, in recognition of the contribution that members of the Armed Forces past, present and future make to our society.

Report

Request for Fee Waiver – Public Entertainment Licence – Armed Forces Day 2019

1. **Recommendations**

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee:
- 1.1.1 Hears from the licence holder; and
- 1.1.2 Determines the appropriate level of fee for this event.

2. Background

- 2.1 Armed Forces Day is an annual event, recognising the contribution that members of the Armed Forces make to society. This community event and parade are planned for Saturday 22 June 2019 from 10.30am to 3.00pm.
- 2.2 The Culture and Communities Events team work with Veterans Charities and Associations to help with the event planning and organisation.

3. Main report

- 3.1 A Public Entertainment License fee for this type of event is required, at a cost of £155.
- 3.2 The Lord Provost has written to the Convener to request that Committee consider waiving the fee for the Public Entertainment License for this event.
- 3.3 A copy of the License application is attached in appendix 1 and the letter from the Lord Provost is attached in appendix 2. Appendix 3 shows the plan for St Andrew Square, where the community event will take place.
- 3.4 The charge for Public Entertainment Licenses is used to offset the significant infection costs which are incurred in dealing with Licensing issues in the city.
- 3.5 A representative of the applicant will be invited to address the Committee on the request for the fee refund

4 Measures of success

4.1 The premises are licensed in a proportionate and effective manner.

5 Financial impact

- 5.1 The cost of the Armed Forces Day parade and community event is met by the Council.
- 5.2 The Council's scale of fees for licensing applications was approved with effect from 1 April 2019.
- 5.3 Committee should note that the Council approved the following as part of the Budget Motion approved in February 2019:
 - 5.3.1 The Administration will adopt a policy of full cost recovery for major events in the city delivered by third parties. We will increase cost recovery through charges levied for licensing and regulatory services, road occupation licences and consents, where permitted by legislation.
- 5.4 The cost of waiving the license fee will be met from the Licensing budget.

6 Risk, policy, compliance and governance impact

- 6.1 The process outlined takes account of the relevant statutory provisions.
- 6.2 The fee structure was agreed by Council in February 2019. Any reduction risks setting a precedent. However, Committee has discretion to waive fees where it considers this appropriate.
