### Item – 7.7 Houses of Multiple Occupation (HMO) - Raising Standards Motion update

Adds:

1.1.5 The consultation on the Best Practice Guide should include provisions designed to encourage

- i) improved neighbour notification of HMO licence applications, whether new or renewals.
- ii) enhanced contact details being provided to neighbouring residents on an annual basis by including the names of both the landlord and the agent, if there is one, and the telephone number and email address of a named individual.
- iii) better compliance with Council Waste policies by subcontractors acting on behalf of a landlord or agent to make appropriate arrangements with the Council or other collecting contractor for the disposal and/or uplift of any building materials, bulking items or other refuse which are inappropriate for residential waste streams.
