### **Executive Summary**

The City of Edinburgh Council has been notified of several parades which are proposed to take place in September 2022.

The Council has limited powers in respect of parades. It can take no action and the parade would proceed as the organisers intend. Alternatively, it has the power to attach conditions or, under limited circumstances, to ban the parade. The Committee needs to decide whether to exercise any of these options.

In January 2018 the Regulatory Committee decided to continue the practice that all marches involving the High Street must be submitted for Committee consideration.

# **Proposed Parades and Processions: September 2022**

#### 1. Recommendations

1.1 It is recommended that the Committee makes an order in respect of each of the proposed parades, attaching the conditions attached at Appendix 2.

## 2. Background

- 2.1 Under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, anyone organising a parade or procession in Scotland must notify the appropriate local authority and the police at least 28 days prior to the date of the event.
- 2.2 The City of Edinburgh Council has been notified of intent to hold the following events in the city (further details in Appendix 1). The organisers of all three parades wish to use the High Street.

- 2.3 The Council has limited powers available regarding the control of parades. These powers should only normally be exercised to prevent public disorder, risk to public safety, damage to property or excessive disruption to the life of the community.
  <u>Download the Scottish Government Guidance to local authorities on marches and parades.</u>
- 2.4 All parades will go ahead unless the Council decides to make use of its statutory powers. No concerns or objections have been raised by any Council team or by the Police with respect to these parades.

#### 3. Main report

- 3.1 Notification forms relevant to the proposed parades are attached at Appendix 1.
- 3.2 The recommended conditions (Appendix 2) are sufficient to mitigate any possible disruption to the community.
- 3.3 Representatives of the organisations will be invited to address the Committee regarding the proposed parades.

#### 4. Measures of success

- 4.1 That the Council discharges its statutory duties in respect of these notifications.
- 4.2 That any parade is facilitated wherever possible and is managed in a way that minimises potential disruption to the life of the community.

#### 5. Financial impact

- 5.1 None arising directly from this report.
- 5.2 Council resources may need to be deployed on the day, in particular with respect to any road closures.

### 6. Risk, policy, compliance and governance impact

6.1 Should the Committee decide to restrict or prohibit the procession, the persons proposing to hold the procession may appeal against that decision to the Sheriff Court within 14 days of written reasons being received by them.

# 7. Equalities impact

7.1 In coming to a decision, the Committee will have to consider the rights of the procession organisers to stage their procession, and the Council's duty to foster good relations and ensure the protection of public order and safety. These must be discharged against the relevant statutory duties.

### **Executive Summary**

A Public Entertainment Licence application has been received for Armed Forces Day 2022. Armed Forces Day was 25 June 2022. The former Lord Provost has written to request that the Licensing Sub-Committee considers waiving the fee for this Public Entertainment Licence, in recognition of the contribution that members of the Armed Forces make to our society.

# Request for Fee Waiver – Public Entertainment Licence – Armed Forces Day 2022

#### 1. Recommendations

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee:
- 1.1.1 Determines the appropriate level of fee for this event.

#### 2. Background

- 2.1 Armed Forces Day is an annual event, recognising the contribution that members of the Armed Forces make to society. This community event and parade took place on Saturday 25 June 2022.
- 2.2 The Culture and Communities Events team works with veterans' charities and associations to help with the event planning and organisation.
- 2.3 This request is being sent to Committee for consideration as officers are required to ensure full cost recovery for all licences and have no delegation to waive fees.

### 3. Main report

- 3.1 A Public Entertainment Licence fee for this type of event is required, at a cost of £173. The former Lord Provost wrote to the former Convener to request that the Committee considers waiving the fee for the Public Entertainment Licence for this event. A copy of the licence application is attached at Appendix 1 and the letter from the former Lord Provost is attached at Appendix 2.
- 3.2 The charge for Public Entertainment Licences is used to offset the costs which are incurred in dealing with Licensing issues in the city.
- 3.3 A representative of the applicant will be invited to address the Committee on the request for the fee refund.

#### 4 Measures of success

4.1 The premises are licensed in a proportionate and effective manner.

# 5 Financial impact

- 5.1 The cost of the Armed Forces Day parade and associated events are met by the Council.
- 5.2 The Council's scale of fees for licensing applications was approved with effect from 1 April 2022.
- 5.3 The Committee should note that the Council approved the following as part of the Budget Motion approved in February 2019:
  - 5.3.1 The Administration will adopt a policy of full cost recovery for major events in the city delivered by third parties. We will increase cost recovery through charges levied for licensing and regulatory services, road occupation licences and consents, where permitted by legislation.
- 5.4 The cost of waiving the licence fee will be met from the Licensing budget.

### 6 Risk, policy, compliance and governance impact

- 6.1 The process outlined takes account of the relevant statutory provisions.
- 6.2 The fee structure was agreed by Council in April 2022. Any reduction risks setting a precedent. However, the Committee has discretion to waive fees where it considers this appropriate.

### **Executive Summary**

An application for a Public Entertainment Licence has been received from Saughtonhall United Reformed Church. The applicant has written to request that the Licensing Sub-Committee considers either reducing the Public Entertainment Licence fee or refunding the cost of the organisation's Theatre Licence.

# Request for Fee Reduction – Saughtonhall United Reformed Church

#### 1. Recommendations

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee:
  - 1.1.1 Hears from the applicant; and refuses the request

### 2. Background

- 2.1 Saughtonhall United Reformed Church runs an amateur drama group.
- 2.2 The Theatres Act 1968 previously provided a licensing regime for premises which were used for the public performance of plays.
- 2.3 The Theatres Act 1968 was repealed on 27 January 2021. On 19 August 2019 the Regulatory Committee resolved under section 9 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 to license theatres under its public entertainment licensing regime.

## 3. Main report

- 3.1 Saughtonhall United Reformed Church was granted a Theatre Licence for the period 1 June to 30 November 2020, and the relevant fee of £776 was paid. Due to restrictions imposed during the COVID-19 pandemic, all of the organisation's planned productions during that period had to be cancelled.
- 3.2 A representative of Saughtonhall United Reformed Church has written to the Council (Appendix 1) to request that the committee considers reducing the application fee paid for a Public Entertainment Licence (£1,153).
- 3.3 Refund of a licence fee granted in a previous year is not possible as the accounts for that period have closed. The charge for Public Entertainment Licence applications is used to offset the significant costs which are incurred in dealing with licensing issues in the city. Waiving the Public Entertainment licence fee after the fact would create an unfunded pressure and risks setting a precedent, in that other licence holders or applicants might seek a similar decision in respect of the fee that they have paid.

- 5.2 Committee members should note that the Council approved the following as part of the Budget Motion approved in February 2019:
  - 5.2.1 The Administration will adopt a policy of full cost recovery for major events in the city delivered by third parties. We will increase cost recovery through charges levied for licensing and regulatory services, road occupation licences and consents, where permitted by legislation.
- 5.3 The cost of reducing the licence fee will be met from the Licensing budget.

### 6 Risk, policy, compliance and governance impact

- 6.1 The process outlined takes account of the relevant statutory provisions.
- 6.2 The fee structure was agreed by Council in April 2022. Any reduction risks setting a precedent. However, the committee has discretion to waive fees where it considers this appropriate.

# Use of Urgency Provision of Standing Orders to Allow Grant of Late Hours Catering Licence – Mohammed Lotfi

#### 1. Recommendations

1.1 The Committee is asked to note that a Late Hours Catering Licence was granted to Mohammed Lotfi for premises known as 'Franco's Fish & Chips' at 11 Summerhall Place, Edinburgh using the urgency provision of standing orders after consultation with the Convener.

#### 2. Background

2.1 Standing Orders permit Directors to make urgent decisions provided the relevant Convenor is consulted. Any such decision is required to be reported thereafter to Committee.

#### 3. Main report

- 3.1 On 24 June 2021 the Council received a renewal application from Mohammed Lotfi for a Late Hours Catering Licence for premises known as 'Franco's Fish & Chips' at 11 Summerhall Place, Edinburgh. The application was circulated for consideration and attracted comment from Police Scotland and the Licensing Enforcement team.
- 3.2 In such circumstances the application would normally be referred to the Committee for a decision. However, this application was mislaid and it was not actively worked on until March 2022. At this point, it was identified that the application was outwith policy and objections had been received. The applicant amended the requested hours, which satisfied one of the two requirements of the late hours catering policy, however there was still an outstanding requirement which was partly met as the applicant managed to secure letters of support from some of the neighbours.
- 3.3 There was not a Committee meeting scheduled within the required timescales and thus the renewal was granted by the Executive Director of Place using urgency provisions within Standing Orders, after consultation with the Convener.
- 3.4 As required, the use of urgency provisions is hereby reported to the committee.

4.1 The premises are licensed in a proportionate and effective manner.
