## Proposed Parades: June - August 2023

### 1. Recommendations

---

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee makes orders in respect of the proposed parades, attaching standard conditions (Appendix 2).

### 2. Background

---

- 2.1 Under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, anyone organising a parade or procession in Scotland must notify the appropriate local authority and the police at least 28 days prior to the date of the event.
- 2.2 The City of Edinburgh Council has been notified of intent to hold the following events in the city (further details in Appendix 1). It is proposed that parades (a) and (d) will use the High Street. In addition, it is proposed that parades (a), (b), (c) and (e) will use Princes Street.

- 2.3 No objections have been received regarding the use of Princes Street. However, the organisers of parade (a) (Edinburgh Taxi Trade Children's Outing) will be required to obtain permission from Police Scotland to turn right from Princes Street to the Mound.
- 2.4 The Council has limited powers available regarding the control of parades. These powers should only normally be exercised to prevent public disorder, risk to public safety, damage to property or excessive disruption to the life of the community.
