Item No. 7.1 - Private Hire Car Overprovision

- 1. Notes the report and thanks the officers for the provision of detailed information.
- 2. Notes the report discharges the remit from the motion passed at full Council on 24 October 2019.
- 3. Notes particularly
 - a. Comparative information (Appendix 3) shows the number of PHCs per resident in Edinburgh is generally lower than other comparator cities
 - b. Comparative information (Appendix 3) shows the proportion of PHCs in relation to taxis is lower than or equal to that in 5 of the 8 comparator cities, and Aberdeen and Dundee which have lower rates, are significantly smaller than Edinburgh
 - c. The estimated £100,000 research costs to begin considering whether to introduce a cap on PHC numbers
 - d. There will be other ongoing additional costs in relation to administering and regulating a cap
 - e. The costs any such additional costs will ultimately be paid by the public
 - f. The Guidance on *Power to refuse to Grant Private Hire Licences on Grounds of Overprovision* from the Scottish Government (Appendix 1)
 - g. The Guidance from the Competition and Markets Authority (Appendix2) noting additional hurdles to implementing a cap
 - h. The lack of evidence giving rise to significant public safety concerns (paras 4.21 to 4.24)
 - i. That the available data on complaints and suspensions (paras 4:21 to 4.35) do not found significant grounds for a cap on PHC numbers
- 4. Resolves not to engage an external consultant at this time and to keep the issue under review annually.
