### 1. Proposed Parades and Processions September/October 2021

#### 1.1 Escort to the Crown for Opening Parliament

Details were provided of a proposed parade “Escort to the Crown for Opening Parliament” to be held on 2 October 2021. The Event Organiser and the appropriate Council officers were heard.

#### Decision

To make an Order in respect of the proposed Escort to the Crown for Opening Parliament parade on 2 October 2021 within the designated route and times imposing conditions that:

- 1) The parade shall proceed in accordance with the route and times specified in the Notices of Proposal.
- 2) The standard conditions recommended by the Council’s Regulatory Services Manager shall be applied.
