Planning Appeal Statement

Property: 2/6 Gayfield Close, Edinburgh, EH1 3NA

Planning application reference: 22/06000/FULSTL

We are submitting an appeal in regards to the above-mentioned planning application which was refused by The City of Edinburgh Council on 14 April 2023 (appeal made within 3 months of decision date).

Background: An application for change of use was made on 05 December 2022 in order to comply with the 'Short Term Let Control Area', which requires all proprietors wishing to use their properties within Edinburgh City Centre as short term lets to have planning permission, if the property is classed as a secondary letting. The application was open to public comments until 06 January 2023 – there were no comments received during this period. The councils given determination date at the time of application was 03 February 2023 however this was not actually determined until 14 April 2023 – approximately 19 weeks.

The decision to refuse the change of use was in relation to the Local Development Plan Policy Hou 7 in respect of Inappropriate Uses in Residential Areas, the description of this policy as follows:

The intention of the policy is firstly, to preclude the introduction or intensification of non-residential uses incompatible with predominantly residential areas and secondly, to prevent any further deterioration in living conditions in more mixed-use areas which nevertheless have important residential functions. This policy will be used to assess proposals for the conversion of a house or flat to a House in Multiple Occupation (i.e. for five or more people). Further advice is set out in Council Guidance.

The property is located in a mixed-use development constructed in the 1990's, consisting of residential and commercial units. The residential block in which the flat is located comprises of 6 flats; 2 of which are long-term lets and 3 which are second homes – the second homes are vacant for the majority of the year. Before purchasing the property in December 2016 this was also a second home for the previous owner - which was largely vacant throughout the year. At the time of purchase, the property had been listed as a fixed price sale and had been on the market in excess of 5 months. Following the purchase there has been considerable investment to upgrade the flat to ensure compliance with the current rental standards. There is no history of the property being a primary residence for any occupier since its construction. We have also attached a supporting statement with this appeal from Philip G Meaden who has been leading the Gayfield Court Proprietors' Association for the last 7 years, for your consideration.

The top of Leith Walk is diversely populated with residential, commercial and retail units, we consider the proposed use of this property as short-term let within a development consisting of 20 flats being proportionate to this diversity. The flat has provided short term accommodation for the past 6 years for clients visiting and working within the city, the merits of this accommodation are evident in the reviews received on various platforms; outlined in the planning statement. The property offers a good alternative to hotels, for those who are looking for a more home-from-home experience and prefer a bit more flexibility & space. There is a 2-night minimum booking policy which minimises the opportunities for anti-social behaviour (party bookings). The use of the property as a short term let inherently attracts visitors to the City which in turn helps to generate income for the local economy, this also provides additional employment for local trades/businesses in regards to maintenance and cleaning.

Whilst we understand the planner's assessment of the application in regards to the local development plan, we do not agree that the proposed use of this property as a short-term let is detracting any further from the immediate area. We therefore request for the Planning Local Review Body to reassess this decision by The City of Edinburgh Council planning department, in favour of this change of use application.
