1. Quorum

In the absence of a quorum, the members present agreed to discuss the items on the agenda and submit their recommendations to the next meeting of the Committee.

2. Minute

The minute of the Audit and Assurance Committee from the 13 September 2023 was presented for approval as a correct record and any matters arising.

5. Annual Cycle of Business

6. EIJB Risk Register

The latest iteration of the Edinburgh Integration Joint Board (EIJB) risk register was presented for endorsement. It was noted that as a key part of its governance process, the risk register documents the risks that impact the Edinburgh Integration Joint Board's (EIJB) ability to deliver its objectives.

Decision

- 2) To agree the risk overview, assurance levels and risk cards at appendix 1,2 3, acknowledging and that work continues to strengthen and improve the narrative and evidence base contained within the risk cards;
- 3) To note progress to date in relation to recruitment to the Chief Risk Officer;
- 4) To agree that the Chief Finance Officer and Operations Manager will continue to embed the EIJB risk process; and
- 5) To note that officers would highlight cognisance of the delay in the delivery of the Strategic Plan in the next iteration of the risk card.

7. Committees' Annual Assurance Framework – 2023/24 Cyle

This recommended approach for the 2023/24 committee annual assurance statement process was presented. The Edinburgh Integration Joint Board (EIJB) agreed its Board Assurance Framework on 22 March 2022 and requested all EIJB committees submit an annual assurance statement covering the remit of the committees and should support the assurance levels the committees are providing to the EIJB and identify any significant issues.

9. Internal Audit Update

Details of the progress of Internal Audit assurance activity including progress with closing audit actions between 15 September to 20 November 2023 was presented.

The 2023/24 EIJB Internal Audit Plan includes three audits and follow-up of audit actions from previous EIJB internal audits. Details of relevant audit work have been presented to either the NHS Lothian Audit and Risk Committee or the Council's Governance, Risk and Best Value Committee as well as Audit Scotland publications during the reporting period are provided for consideration.

The outcomes from the six monthly meeting between the EIJB Audit and Assurance Committee and GRBV Convenors and the Head of Internal Audit held in October 2023 were also presented.

Planning for the 2024/25 EIJB Internal Audit Plan has commenced. A list of previously completed audits and areas for consideration to aid committee discussion is provided. Details of revised engagement opinions aligned to EIJB and NHS Lothian are also provided.

Decision

- 1) To note the progress with delivery of the EIJB 2023/24 Internal Audit Plan;
- 2) To note audit work completed by both NHSL and the Council in the last period, and considerations on Audit Scotland's Adult Mental Health report;

- 4) To note the outcomes of the six monthly meeting between the EIJB Audit and Assurance Committee and GRBV Convenors with the Head of Internal Audit, as agreed as part of the GRBV/EIJB principles;
- 5) To note the discussion on audits for inclusion in the 2024/25 Internal Audit Plan, and that the draft plan with be presented to the March Committee meeting for discussion and approval; and
- 6) To recommend that the Audit and Assurance Committee agree to the adoption of the revised engagement opinions.
