2. Executive Summary

- 2.1. This report advises Council on the request made by Cramond and Barnton Community Council to change their name to Cramond, Barnton and Cammo Community Council.
- 2.2. Endorsement is therefore sought to approve a change of name for Cramond and Barnton Community Council to Cramond, Barnton and Cammo Community Council.

3. Background

- 3.1. Current support arrangements for Edinburgh's community councils took effect following the agreement of the Scheme for community councils in June 2019.
- 3.2. A new Scheme and boundaries for community councils will take effect from 28 March 2025.

4. Main report

- 4.1. Cramond and Barnton Community Council notified the Council that, at their meeting on 12 September 2024, they agreed to change their name from Cramond and Barnton Community Council to Cramond, Barnton and Cammo Community Council.
- 4.2. Under the current Scheme for community councils, paragraph 13.1 states:
 - 4.2.1. Any request to change the boundaries and names of community councils must be made in writing to the Council Elections Manager who will arrange for the request to be submitted to the appropriate City of Edinburgh Council committee.
