Item – 8.3 Progress Report on the ‘Vision for Water Management’ and Operational Management of Roads Drainage Infrastructure

Committee:

Accepts recommendations 1.1.1 to 1.1.4, but re-numbers 1.1.4 to 1.1.7.

Adds the following:

1.1.4 Specifically, asks the Executive Director of Place to prepare a gully recovery programme that identifies the organisation and resources required to deliver an efficient proactive and reactive maintenance regime to minimise flooding risks due to any gully issues within the control of this Council;

1.1.5 For clarity, expects the dedicated multi-disciplinary in-house team to include provision for regular road / gutter clearing, to minimise the build up of any detritus that might restrict the efficiency / effectiveness of the drainage networks that support our pavements, paths or roads;

1.1.6 Expects that costed options to achieve the above will be available to inform the 2022/23 budget debate;

1.1.8 Requires a follow up report, less this important topic be lost, to this Committee (or any successor Committee) following the formation of a new Council after the forthcoming local elections and in light of any new budget provisions.
