<p>Edinburgh Slavery and Colonialism Legacy Review</p> <p>The independent Edinburgh Slavery and Colonialism Legacy Review Group met for the fifth time on 17 January 2022 (postponed from December due to illness).</p> <p>Since the August meeting, a working party of both Review and Advisory Group members had drafted the online consultation survey which was launched on the Consultation Hub and ran from October until mid-January. This was supported by a communications campaign encouraging wide participation through social media channels and signposting in communities.
