- Noise pollution from open speakers.

- Anti-social behaviour, i.e. the use of the speakers at night.
- Pavement obstruction - the new advertising boards will further obstruct the pedestrian footway on a very busy high street and add to street clutter.

Finally, I object in principle to the commercialisation of public space. The existing derelict phone box should be removed by BT without local residents having to concede any amenity to a commercial operator.
